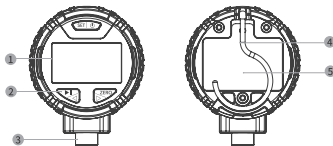
USER MANUAL

ENSURE SAFETY

- Do not operate the instrument if there are signs of damage at the housing.
- The instruments are compatible with most noncorrosive refrigerants, water and glycol.
- The instruments are not compatible with refrigerants containing ammonia.
- The products must not be used in potentially explosive atmospheres!
- Dangers may also arise from the refrigeration systems being measured or the measuring environment: Note the safety regulations valid in your area when performing the measurements.

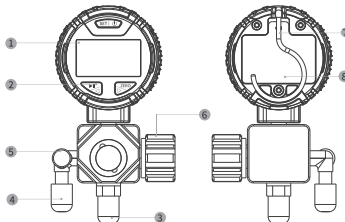

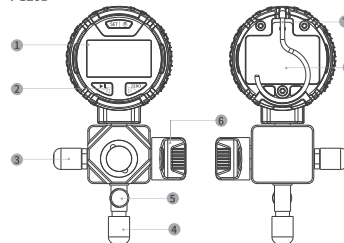

① The APO icon lighting up indicates that the automatic shutdown function is enabled. Automatic shutdown does not work during the pressure-holding process.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Temperature unit settings

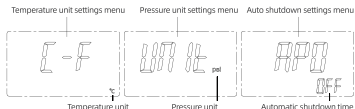
- Press Enter the settings menu, the instrument displays the C-F interface.
- Press / Choose temperature unit.

2. Pressure unit settings

- Press Enter the settings menu and press the briefly again to switch to the UNIT settings screen.
- Press / Choose pressure unit.

3. Exit Settings

- Press Enter the settings menu, press Switch through the settings menu in order, then exit.
- The settings menu will automatically exit after 5 seconds of inactivity.



4. Auto Power Off

- press Enter the settings menu and press the briefly again to switch to the UNIT settings screen
- press / Set the automatic shutdown time or turn off the automatic shutdown feature

5. Setting Refrigerant

- Short press or to select the correct refrigerant.

6. Reset to Zero

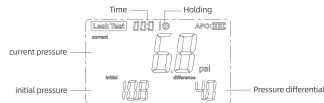
- Keep the instrument connector connected to the atmosphere, long press to zero the pressure.

① Pressure zeroing should be carried out when the instrument is not connected to the target system and the instrument interface is connected to the atmosphere, incorrect zeroing will make the measurement data inaccurate, if misuse follow the correct method to re-zero can be restored to normal.

7. Pressure Leak Test

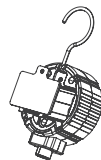
- Long press + the instrument enter the pressure leak test function.
- Long press start holding, the instrument starts timing and displays the initial pressure, real-time pressure, and pressure difference.

- During the test, long press to pause the pressure-holding test. During the pause, short press to reset the test duration and data.
- Long press + to exit the pressure-holding function.



- ① The pressure test cannot start when the pressure is below 0, and the instrument does not respond to operations.
- ① The maximum pressure-holding timer is 24 hours. Once it reaches 24 hours, the device will automatically stop holding pressure.

CHANGING BATTERIES



- Switch off the instrument and fold the hook.
- Loosen the fixing screws of the battery compartment cover.
- Snap open the battery compartment cover along the groove at the bottom of the compartment.
- Remove the spent batteries and insert new ones into the battery compartment. Observe the Polarity.
